

Hello fellow residents of the Adamstown Village. The Adamstown Village Citizen's Association has signed up to participate in the County's Adopt-A-Road program to improve the environment, make our neighborhood an even better place to live, and to spend some fun time with our neighbors we might not get to see as often as we'd like. Our adopted roadway is the section of Adamstown Road between New Design Road and Rt. 85. We've scheduled our first cleanup for Saturday, July 7, with the details listed below.

**Clean-up Date:** Saturday, July 7 at 8am

**Rain Date:** Saturday, July 14 at 8am

**Meeting Place:** Carroll Manor Elementary School (CMES) parking lot

**Training Session for new participants:** 8:00am – 8:10am at CMES

**Please bring the following, if possible:**

1. Cell phone
2. Water bottle
3. Gloves
4. Hat
5. Sunscreen
6. First aid kit
7. Long pants

**We will provide:**

1. Trash bags
2. Safety vests
3. Two safety warning signs we will post at each end of our designated section of Adamstown Road
4. An opportunity for safety training at 8am sharp for anyone who did not get to see the training video at our March meeting.

**General Do's & Don'ts:**

1. Twelve people max per group (we may divide into two groups: one group starting on Rt. 85 and the other starting at New Design Road. One group can get started at 8am, while the other group can get started after the ten-minute training session ends)
2. Participate only if you have received clean-up safety training (a brief training session will be provided on 7/7/07 at 8am at CMES)
3. Make sure our orange warning signs are posted at each end of or section of roadway
4. Have a designated spotter watching for oncoming traffic
5. Work facing traffic
6. Wear long pants since there's a lot of poison ivy in the area we will be cleaning
7. Written parental or guardian permission is required for all participants under the age of 18. We will have the forms available at the beginning of the clean-up.

8. Children below the age of 12 and pets cannot participate in the cleanup
9. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited at all times.
